

303rd BG (H) Combat Mission No. 295A

2 January 1945

Target: Communications Center at Prum, Germany &
Railroad Marshalling Yard at Gerolstein, Germany

The 303rd BG(H) furnished three PFF aircraft and crews to the 1st CBW:
#44-8125 B-17G PFF 360BS flew with the 1st CBW-A 91BG lead Squadron as Deputy Leader. This aircraft dropped 12 500-lb. G.P. bombs from 24,900 feet. It was not possible to view the GEE-H bombing results because the bombs dropped through the clouds.

#44-8439 B-17G PFF 360BS flew with the 1st CBW-A 91BG high Squadron as Deputy Leader. This aircraft dropped 12 500-lb. G.P. bombs from 25,900 feet. The railroad line and siding were hit with good results.

#44-8495 B-17G PFF 427BS flew with the 1st CBW-B 381BG lead Squadron as Deputy Leader and took over the lead before the IP. The aircraft achieved fair results when they dropped eight 500-lb. and two M17 bombs from 25,100 feet using GEE-H equipment.
