303RD BOMBARDMENT GROUP (H) MOLESWORTH, ENGLAND 1942-1945


he 1199th Military Police Company, commanded by 1Lt Francis R. Gorman, was responsible for maintaining a constant patrol to guard the aircraft and look for suspicious persons or activities. They provided Base perimeter patrol, and were responsible for all of the entry gates to the station. They furnished guards at briefings and conducted interrogations to keep out unauthorized personnel.

Prior to the formation of the 1199th Military Police Company, the responsibility of guarding the base and provided patrol and visitor control was assigned to the Provost Marshall, Captain **Frank M. Jones**. Men from the various Bomb Squadrons served as military police and patrol and visitor control at the gates. Sometime in early 1944, the 1199th Military Police Company was organized and trained military police specialists arrived at

Molesworth. They took over the functions conducted by the Provost Marshal. Many of the men who had served as military policeman from the Bomb Squadrons were transferred out of Molesworth.



On special occasions, such as the visit of high-ranking officers or the Royal Family, the Company furnished highly efficient guards-of-honor, demonstrating just how military an American soldier can be and, at the same time, furnishing real protection to the visitor.

The low accident rate on Molesworth was directly attributed to the manner in which the Military Police enforced traffic regulations, and prevented absent-minded jeep drivers from wondering in front of taxiing or landing Fortresses.

The 1199th Military Police Company was organized and assigned to Molesworth in March 1944. In April 1945, it became a part of the 425th Air Service

Group and was assigned to the Headquarters and Base Services Squadron.

Horace B. **Jenson** 1199th MP Company related an incident while on duty: On a foggy night, I was on guard duty with a buddy. A 2nd Lieutenant was Officer of the Day, perhaps his first effort. He approached us and I challenged him. He said, "Aren't there supposed to be two guards on this post?" I said, "Of course there are two of us." I shined my light to the ground where I thought my buddy was lying down, but he wasn't there. I looked back to the lieutenant, and there was my buddy with his M-1 about six inches from the O.D.'s face. The lieutenant almost jumped out of his jump suit.
